Pam's pregnancy with her son gained notoriety when the story aired on the night that Tim won the Heisman trophy. Doctors had advised Pam to abort her pregnancy, which she refused to do. It is this story that has given her a national platform for a life-affirming message to young women everywhere. It is that platform that gives her a springboard to discuss her success stories in home schooling her five children. Pam and her husband of 37 years, Bob, have been called "home schooling pioneers" because when they started home schooling in 1982 it was not yet a commonly used phrase. Pam recently retired from her home schooling days after 24 years when her youngest child went off to college. All five of her children received college scholarships and four have graduated while the youngest is currently attending the University of Florida.

The Tebows lived for a number years as missionaries in the Philippines, where they continue to do ministry. The orphanage Uncle Dick's House, founded by the Bob Tebow Evangelistic Association, employs 40 national staff and houses 50 orphans. Pam is actively involved in coordinating numerous projects and personnel, but her heart is encouraging the wives of the staff members. Enjoying numerous writing and speaking engagements, Pam is passionate about encouraging young women to make a life-long decision to trust the Lord with all their hearts.

It is that same passion that matches the core values of Sav-A-Life, Inc. Vestavia. The organization has held true to those values in serving the men and women of Jefferson County and other outlying counties since 1980.
